Job Description

Summary:

Crew Hands perform general oil field construction and maintenance in a team setting. Crew Hands are required to perform physically demanding labor in all outside weather conditions and work long hours when necessary.

Essential Job Functions:

- Must Maintain a safe work environment for themselves and others
- Must maintain condition of company property and maintain all necessary inspections.
- Must have a positive attitude and work well in a team environment.
- Must be able to take direction from Crew Foreman and/or Management Staff
- Must perform ALL tasks to company standards both safely and efficiently
- Must be willing to work long hours; 40 hours a week with occasional overtime, 5 days a week with possible weekends.
- All Crew Hands are required to wear – Approved fire-retardant (FR) cover-alls, hard hat, safety (steel) toed work boots, and eye protection AT ALL TIMES. Hearing protecting, harnesses, respirators and other appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) may also be required if necessary.
- Must have basic mechanical ability along with the ability to utilize various hand/power tools safely and efficiently. Those include but are not limited to: hammers, pipe wrenches, end wrenches, hammer wrenches, pipe cutters, threaders, power heads, shovels, rakes, post hole diggers, chain vices, screw drivers, etc.
- Must maintain professional relationship with company personnel and customers at all times.
- Must be able to perform physical activity including but not limited to: shoveling, climbing ladders and stairs, lifting, carrying heavy objects exceeding 100 lbs., support body weight with arms only, running, walking, sitting for extended periods of time, etc.

Qualifications and Education Requirements:

- Must be able to effectively communicate and understand the English language.
- High School Diploma or GED preferred.
- Valid driver's license and/or transportation to/from company office or yard.
- Must be able to pass all drug testing as required by company policy (pre-employment, random, upon suspicion)
- Must complete a physical capability test.
- Must maintain a clean Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) if driving for the company and criminal background.
- Safeland and/or any other required safety courses
- Must be able to pass written competency test after Short Service Employee (SSE) probationary period.
- Must maintain a safe work environment consistently
- Ability to perform tasks accurately and thoroughly
- Ability to find solutions for and/or to deal with day-to-day work-related problems efficiently



- Ability to comprehend complex topics and specialized information
- Ability to complete work-related tasks in stressful situations
- Ability of decipher safe and un-safe working conditions and implement best course of action
- Ability to communicate effectively with others, either through verbal or written communication.
- Ability to maintain a productive work environment at all times.
- Ability to remain attentive to detail and provide feedback when necessary
